### History In Person

*“Living history in your living room!”*

Imagine an intimate conversation with some of the movers and shakers in world history, people whose decisions shaped our world and whose lives still inspire us today. These historical characters are telling true stories of the pivotal moments in their lives in a compelling performance. We have filmed more than 20 half-hour episodes and we have a full season slated to be done in the next several weeks. With the right sponsorship, our diverse line-up could include authors Walt Whitman and Harriet Beecher Stowe, scientists like Marie Curie and Charles Darwin, artists John James Audubon and Georgia O’Keefe, four friends of Lincoln, several first ladies and presidents, soldiers from most major battles, and a series of Explorers, Immigrants and Pioneers. We will also feature young performers on a regular basis to help build audience engagement and to build young scholars’ enthusiasm about these Chautauqua style programs.



### Fox Tales Folklore

*History and Science Woven in a Tapestry of Delightful Tales*



Fairy tales and fables, poetry and personal narratives are stitched together in a patchwork quilt that uses threads from social studies, science and language arts. As one friend said, “Fox imbues his folktales with true science and writes non-fiction with the drama of a fairy tale.” Every episode includes a mix of story types and a call to action to inspire

students to explore the world around them, write their own stories, and to go outside to study their local environment. So far there are five books filmed as part of the series: A River of Stories, Tall Tree Tales, Bird Tales, Fox Tales and Prairie Fire! Other books in the pipeline include Bear Tales, Fish Tales, In A Spring Garden, Speaking Truth to Power, Celtic Tales, Native American Star Stories, and Native Ghosts. With more than 400 stories in his repertoire and a dozen friends with a larger reservoir of stories, we can easily cover almost any topic within your curriculum. We also feature young voices from Niche Theater Arts and are holding the door wide open for your students to submit stories we will air, giving students an added incentive to write and perform their own stories, to find their own voice!

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Every episode comes with engaging lesson plans that integrate reading historical texts, creative writing, and hands-on science, math, S.T.E.M., art, music, and/or the special content that program best embodies. Lesson plans are available as simple pdf documents. Knowing that many students and teachers are rising to meet the challenge of a virtual education, these programs are being launched now to support schools in their search for accessible, curriculum driven content. WTVP in Peoria has green lighted the project and it premiered September 14th. We are now in the process of reaching out to other PBS affiliates. We have built an enthusiastic team including veteran videographers ProVideo and Twin City productions; Niche Theater Arts is recruiting and training young performers, and a consulting producer from Live Story Productions is onboard to help us grow a national audience.

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
